As part of 'Science Week' we held an Eco Fashion Show in science. These sessions highlighted the amount of waste that is thrown away, which could be recycled and put to good use.

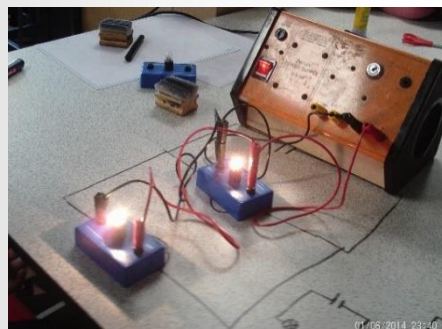


Exploration
