LITERACY FOCUS: READING STRATEGIES!

Did you know your child should be reading for 10 minutes every night? Did you know that they should have a reading book with them every day in school? This is because we are trying to build a love of reading across the whole school! Over the next few weeks we will offer you some ideas to help them at home.



Which strategies are appropriate for the text?

Skim and scan: Skim-glance quickly through the text to gather a meaning on the whole. Scan-glance quickly through the text to extract specific information.

Track and trace: using a ruler or pen to follow the words of the text as they go.
