From the start of the 2019/2020 Academic Year, school bus fares will increase in line with inflation. We have been notified of the following changes:

An IGO card costs £10 and lasts until 31<sup>st</sup> August after your child's 16th birthday.

The card allows 11-16 year olds to travel using child tickets on buses and trams in Greater Manchester.
