



Welcome back to Science!

Our amazing Year 7 pupils have got stuck in to their science studies straight away and they have been introduced to working with equipment such as Bunsen burners for heating substances and shown how to safely use chemicals such as hydrochloric acid. They have enjoyed their learning and are currently working towards their Bunsen Burner certificates to prove their proficiency with the equipment.



Coming next is a great topic, *'investigating how penguins are able to stay warm in Antarctica'*.

Year 8 pupils have been learning about our digestive system and just how long the small intestine really is.

Year 9 pupils have been studying Darwin's Theory of Natural Selection and modelling this in lessons to discover how birds adapt to different conditions.



Year 10 have made a fantastic start to GCSE Science and have recently been developing their knowledge and understanding of the Periodic Table and how we came to understand the atomic model.



Year 11 pupils have been studying Photosynthesis and will be starting revision for their mock examinations very soon.
